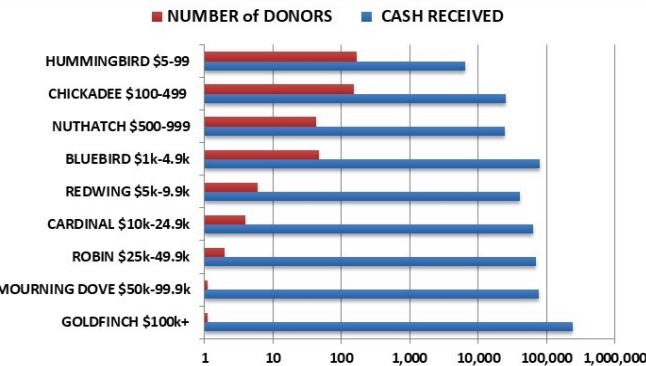

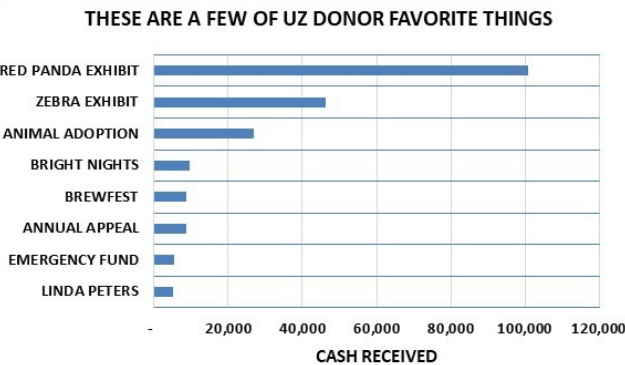
We proudly report that the total amount
raised in 2021 was **\$631,530.***

For the statistically inclined, here we show the donation distributions by BIRD/ DONOR family. For example, our most populous family (HUMMINGBIRDS) consisted of 168 donors, who contributed a total of \$6,443. There was one donor each in the MOURNING DOVE (\$76,750) and GOLDFINCH (\$244,123) family.

Utica Zoo Education

After a year of mostly virtual programs in 2020, our education team was able to expand our programing to offer more in person options for 2021, while still having virtual opportunities during the times where COVID-19 cases were on the rise or for facilities that could not yet welcome us back in person! Among the virtual programs we offered this year, we were able to develop our virtual hatchlings program for a private preschool program. We met virtually once a week over the course of 6 weeks to teach the young learners who were part of this program about some of the amazing animals we have at the zoo!

During July and August, we visited libraries across the area with our zoomobile for the Mid York Library System’s Summer reading program entitled “Tails and Tales.” Our educators taught at 25 libraries in and around

Central New York about the different ways that animals utilize their tails to survive in their habitats. We were also able to expand our offerings of Summer Zoo Camp as well, providing programs for preschoolers through high schoolers over the school break.

We are happy to be able to continue to offer virtual programs to those unable to visit us across New York State, as well as seeing a return to in person visits.

John James Audubon (1785-1851)

He proclaimed himself an “unfettered and self-reliant woodsman”. From 1805, he traveled extensively throughout America drawing and studying wildlife. “My knapsack, my gun, and my dog were all I had for baggage and company.”

In 1863, the New York Historical Society purchased 430 original Birds of America watercolors from his widow, Lucy Audubon. Even then, the works were recognized as one of the finest accomplishments in American art and an important document in the natural history of the world.
